

35-Yr-Old Man Electrocuted While Dismantling Christmas **Decorations In Delta**



ASABA - A 35-year-old man identified as Jaja was Tuesday electrocuted by Christmas decorations used to beautify the Delta State Capital, Asaba.

Daily Independent gathered that the electrician was said to have been engaged by contractor of Asaba Capital Territory on beautification to dismantle the decorations.

It was gathered that the victim was electrocuted while he was trying to bring down the decorations along the popular Okpanam Road, Oshimili South Local Government Area.

It was revealed that one of the life-wires of the electric polls connected to the decorations, fell on the metal ladder on which the victim was standing, killing him on the spot.

Our source, a close friend of the deceased simply Identified as Valentine revealed that the body of the victim had been taken to the morgue in Federal Medical Centre, Asaba.

"The cable wire fell on the metal ladder he was using to remove the decorations and killed her immediately. There was nothing we could do to save her at that point," he said.
