

Police Arrest Woman For Allegedly Killing Husband In Delta

WARRI – The Delta State Police Command has arrested a woman who allegedly killed her husband (father of two) identified as Sylvester in Ugbuwangue Community in Warri South Local Government Area of Delta State.

Daily Independent had earlier reported that the woman reportedly killed her husband.

Sources said that the women, allegedly “killed her husband, the father of her children in Ugbuwangwe area of Warri.

“The wife allegedly used the heel of her shoe to hit her husband on Friday afternoon, accusing him of womanising. The man reportedly slumped and died on the spot,” the sources said.

When contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer, DSP Onome Onovwakpoyeya, confirmed the arrest to our correspondent on phone.

She said, “Nobody had come to report the matter to the Police as at this time you are calling; the lady was arrested for two reasons.

“She is being arrested to keep her in protective custody. And the other, so that we can find her whenever she is needed.

“She has made some confessions to the Police about the incident. But no-one from the family or around has come to report the matter.

“We are going on with her statement, that she didn’t use her shoe on him. Until we have anything different. Investigation is still on.

“However, the remains of the deceased had been deposited in a morgue.”

It was not clear if the deceased legally or traditionally paid the woman’s pride price. But residents around said the lady and the man who is in his 40s had two children and had been living together.

Other sources said, “We don’t know if they had fulfilled all marriage rites but they have children and had been living together.
