## One Shot Dead As Youths Battle Security Operatives In Jangebe

Violence broke out on Wednesday in Jangebe, the Zamfara State community where some schoolgirls were abducted last week, resulting in the death of one person.

Other persons were said to have sustained injuries at a meeting involving government's officials.

Unfortunately, chaos ensued after anxious parents disrupted the speech of Alhaji Nasiru Muazu Magarya, Speaker of the Zamfara House of Assembly, and forcefully took their daughters away.

The schoolgirls, who arrived at the school in the evening, were seated in the examination hall and were being addressed by the speaker when the visibly disturbed parents broke into the hall and started throwing insults at the dignitaries that were meant to address the parents and the schoolgirls.
