Driver Dies In Accident Involving Gombe Governor's Convoy

The convoy of Governor Inuwa Yahaya of Gombe State was reportedly involved in an accident on Thursday.

The incident was said to have happened while the governor was returning to his state from Bauchi where he attended a meeting of the North East Governors' Forum.

This is happening two days after the convoy of Governor Bala Mohammed of Bauchi was involved in an accident where 10 policemen sustained injuries but no life was lost.

According to reports, one of the tyres of the SUV conveying the Director-General, Press Affairs, Ismaila Uba Misilli, burst while in motion.

The driver of the vehicle, identified as Malam Babangida, was said to have lost control of the vehicle and lost his life in the process while the other occupants sustained injuries.

Those in the ill-fated vehicle were identified as Umar Mahmud Gwani of GMC TV, his Cameraman, Mohammed Adamu Osama, and a Photographer, Malam Auwal.

The injured victims were reported to have been taken to the Federal Teaching Hospital, Gombe, for treatment.
