## Six Dead, Two Injured As Violence Rocks Enugu Community

No fewer than six people were shot dead while two others were injured following an attack carried out by unknown hoodlums at Adani Community in Enugu State.

Checks revealed that property, shops and houses worth millions of Naira were also destroyed as a result of the

violence.

CP Mohammed Ndatsu Aliyu, Commissioner of Police, Enugu State Command, who led a team of security agencies to the area on Monday vowed not leave any stone unturned to deal with the perpetrators of the violence.

He said, "The violence was allegedly perpetrated in the wee hours of March 28, 2021, by yet to be identified hoodlums, and this led to the death of six persons and gunshot injuries for two others as well

as the burning down of some shops and destruction of property."

The commissioner, while calling for calm ordered the State CID to conduct tacit investigation to identify and bring perpetrators of the unfortunate incident to book.

He further reassured the commitment of the command to collaborate with other security agencies and relevant stakeholders in the community to avert reoccurrence of the violence.
