

Gunmen Kill Two In Delta

Gunmen suspected to be hired assassins have reportedly shut dead a man identified simply as Aguyi at Ope junction in Lower Erejuwa Road, Warri South Local Government Area of Delta State.

Daily Independent gathered that the incident occurred on Saturday afternoon by 1 p.m.

Our source said the gunmen numbering three, two males and a female, came to Ope junction on Saturday afternoon and killed Aguyi.

"They shot him dead. People are alleging that the deceased was shut dead because he is an informant to the police.

"The deceased reportedly was shut two years ago, but did not die. This time the gunmen ensured that he was dead before they left. They came in daylight without fear. Nobody is safe in this country. Federal govern-

ment should do something about these killings as they are too many for the citizens of this country to bear anymore," he said.

In another development, a security operative identified simply as vigilante was also reportedly attacked and killed by unknown hoodlums at the popular Hausa Quarters in Igboodu community on Saturday afternoon, April 3, 2021, in the same Warri South Local Government Area of Delta State.

Sources said also said "the deceased (vigilante) only came around with his gun, when the hoodlums saw him and attacked him, thinking that he came for them."

When contacted, the state Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), Edefe Bright, confirmed the incident saying, "Yes, it is true. A Vigilante was killed. The police are on it. Those responsible will surely have no place to hide."
