Two Die In Road Accident In Anambra

Two separate motor accidents claimed two lives in Anambra state on Sunday.

1 The accidents occurred at Nteje in Oyi local council and 2 Ebenezi in Idemili South local council area.

Opposite Oyi Divisional

Headquarters about 6.30 p.m. an unidentified driver of a Toyota Camry car with registration number KJA 172 CE knocked down a male child crossing the road.

The child was rushed to Chira Hospital, Awkuzu by rescue team of Federal Road Safety officials but was later confirmed

dead by the doctor on duty.

His body has been deposited at Wisdom Mortuary, Nteje.

Six persons comprising one male adult, one female adults, two male children and two female children were involved in the crash.

2 Also by St. Paul's Parish Ebenezi, Nnobi in Idemili

South local council area an unidentified driver knocked down a motorcyclist by 7.32 p.m.

The motorcyclist was riding a CD 125 model motorcycle at the time of the incident.

The Sector Public Education Officer in the state, Mrs. Florence N. Edo, said eyewitness report showed that the

crash was due to poor visibility as it was raining at the time of the crash.

Two male adults were involved in the crash. One male adult, the rider of the motorcycle got injury and was taken to St. Paul's Hospital, Nnobi by a sympathizer; while the passenger was confirmed dead by the doctor on duty at the same hospital.

His body was subsequently deposited at Fatima Morgue, in Awka-Etiti by FRSC rescue team from Nnewi Command.

Following these series of accidents, the Sector Commander Andrew A Kumapayi while condoling with the relatives of the deceased families also warned motorists to avoid driving when there is poor visibility especially when it's raining.
