

Woman, One Other Burnt To Death In Ekiti Road Crash

An unidentified woman died on Wednesday in Iyin-Ekiti while another person got high degree of injuries when two vehicles collided and went up in flame.

Sympathisers watched helplessly as two occupants of one of the buses were consumed by flame.

Confirming the incident, the Police Public Relations Officer, Ekiti Command, ASP Sunday Abutu, said one person died while another was in critical condition.

"Only one person died. The woman got trapped inside the vehicle after the collision and the sympathisers couldn't remove her in time.

"When the vehicle went up in flame, the people were help-

less and the woman got burnt to death in the process.

"However, the second person who got wounded in the same car is currently receiving treatment in the hospital.

"We appeal to road users to be mindful of their speed while driving on the road. They should keep to all rules guiding driving to avert carnage and untimely death of people," Abutu said.
