

Corpse Of Missing NSCDC Personnel Found 18 Months After, Fiancé Arrested

**Incident Throws Benue Command Into Mourning*

MAKURDI – The discovery of the corpse of a female personnel of the Nigeria Security and Civil Defense Corps (NSCDC), Benue State Command, Cynthia Inalegwu Onche who disappeared one and a half year ago has been discovered in a shallow grave in Obi Local Government Area (LGA) of the state.

The corpse of Cynthia who disappeared in Otukpo LGA, a few days to her wedding on 20th December, 2019 was unearthed in far away Obi LGA on Tuesday.

The discovery has thrown the state command of the NSCDC into a state of mourning.

But, while unconfirmed reports have it that the fiancé (names withheld) who was engaged to wed her, before her disappearance in 2019 has been picked up, the Command has refused to comment on the incident.

When asked to comment on the incident, the Command's Public Relations Officer (CPRO), ASC Ejelikwu Michael declined comment on the issue.

He noted that the command was not favourable disposed towards commenting on the issue at the moment, adding that the command may comment on the issue at a later date.

On the other hand, an insider who did not want his name in print confirmed that the report was true.

He observed that it would be difficult for anyone to comment on the issue at the moment because “The demise of Cynthia who was declared missing almost one year ago has thrown the command into a fresh state of mourning. End.
