Gunmen Kill One In Enugu, Police Nab Killer Cultist In Ogun

Tension heightened again on Saturday morning following a fresh attack taunched in Oruku Community in Nkanu East Local Goverment Area of Enugu state, leaving one person dead

It was gathered that the victim of the attack was one Okechukwu Ogbodo, the chairman of Aguikpa Neighborhood Watch.

Check reveals that Ogbodo was passing through Oruku to his Aguikpa autonomous community when he was shot dead while one Donatus Ani, a native of Oruku, was shot on the leg.

The renewed attack threw the community into confusion as gunfire rented the area on Saturday morning

morning.

A resident of the community who spoke on condition of anonymity said: "We thought that another war has started because there were sporadic shootings and we couldn't understand what was happening until we came out of our houses and discovered two persons in the pool of their own blood."

Our correspondent gathered that renewed attacks came two days after the military personnel deployed to the area following the last conflict that claimed the life of the traditional ruler of Oruku, Igwe Emmanuel Mba, were reportedly withdrawn on Thursday, leaving only five policemen behind in the community.

Police Command have
arrested a suspected
cultist who allegedly
killed a rival cult member. He was arrested on
June 7, 2021.

The Police described the suspect, identified as Suleman Kazeem, as a notorious member of the dreaded AYE cult

group.

The suspect was arrested following a distress call received by the DPO Shagamu Division, CSP Okiki Agunblade, that two rival cult groups, Aiye and Eye, confraternities were engaged in a supremacy battle at Latawa area of Sagamu, thereby making life difficult for innocent members of the community.

Upon the distress call, the DPO mobilized his men and moved to the scene.
