## Murder In Ikorodu: Five Suspects In Police Net

he operatives of the Force Criminal Investigations Department (FCID), Abuja, ave arrested five suspects in onnection with the murder a land agent, Yemi Taiwo, ho died on September 8, 2020, ur days after he was abduct by his killers, along with he Femi Animasaun who revived the torture.

They were abducted in the iwu area of Ikorodu.

The arrested suspects were entified as Ola Tijani, Minael James, Ahmed Kasumu unde James and Kose alias harp Shooter."

Daily Independent gathed that they were arrested there a review of the video of the torture incident that algedly led to the death of the and agent.

The arrest of the suspects allowed a directive from the fice of the Inspector General


Police, IGP Alkali Baba, to CID after following petition com the representatives of the survivor of the torture incident, Femi Animasaun, and the wife of the deceased Taiwo, Olabisi Taiwo.

The suspects were said to be some of those identified in the viral video of the dehumanising torture of the deceased and Animasaun, the survivor, inside the premises of Ikorodu North Local Government.

Meanwhile, the wife of the deceased and the survivor as well as their family members have raised the alarm over their safety following reported attacks and threat to their lives from suspected colleagues of the arrested suspects.

The duo of the deceased Taiwo and the survivor prior to the incident were said to be on their way to the former's site in Isiwu on September 4, 2020, when they were abducted, tortured, dehumanised and stripped, which allegedly resulted to Taiwo's death.

The survivor, who claimed that his life had been under threat, said that there had been attempts to kill him by those who saw him as an eye witness to the dastardly act.

Animasaun said that he had to be taken away from the

hospital, where he was rushed to for treatment following the

incident after it was uncovered that some people were trying to eliminate him.

The survivor narrated,
"On the 4th of September
2020, Yemi and I were on our
way to Isiwu to roof his house.
When we got to the bus stop,
some people attacked us and
started beating us."

"They dragged us to the village and more people, mainly suspected cultists, vigilante members, palace boys, dragged us into the local government secretariat, stripped us and hit us with charms and other dangerous weapons."

The survivor also stated,
"At a time, I was about to die,
Yemi was stronger and he kept
assisting me and lifting me up,
whenever they ordered us to
stand up."

He commended the Inspector General of Police Usman Baba Alkali over the arrest of the suspects and pleaded with the police boss to call for the arrest of other members of the gang.

He said, "I want to thank

the IG for arresting them. They have been boasting that they have a godfather in Ikorodu, who is sponsoring them and that they have top police officers with them.

"My life is not safe now I had to be taken away from the hospital, because my people heard that they were planning to kill me, since I was the only witness.

The survivor identified other members of the gang as Isiaka Owolegbon, Rotimi Raji Akeem Tanimowo, Ahmed Tijani, Jimoh Julala, Abass Sido, Akeem Afini, Kayode Raji, Okemati Moshood, Opeyemi Raji Abu Hassan, Saeed Owolegbon, Mojeed Yejini, Taju Oji Waheed Taiku and Segun Arowolo.

Others according to Animasun are Bello Kamoru Wasiu Sowemimo, Wale Ogunbela, Lekan Jabintin, Kareem Mabayoje, Adebowale Asebodunwa Waliu Gori, Bode A. K. A. Bodex, Dada Doyin, Taiye Kehinde, among others.
