

Mall Shut In Ibadan Over Alleged Killing Of Alleged Internet Fraudster

A popular shopping mall in Ibadan, the Oyo State capital, Palms Mall, has been shut down over the alleged killing of an unidentified Internet fraudster on Sunday night.
