One Dead, 15 Injured In Multiple Road Crashes In Onitsha

A multiple road traffic crash in Onitsha has claimed the life of an unidentified middle-aged man while 15 other people were injured on Tuesday.

The crash involved an unidentified driver of a Mercedes Truck 911 marked NEN336YX, another driver of Mercedes 911 Tipper with registration number ACA171XU and yet another unidentified driver of a Mitsubishi L300 Bus with registration Number GDD 547ZP.

Statistics released by Sector Public Relations Officer, Florence N. Edor, for the Sector Commander, said the accident involved 10 male adults and five female adults.

Of the number one male and one female adults got vary-

ing degrees of injury and were taken to the hospital by a good Samaritan.

However, a yet-to-be identified male adult who was taken to Toronto Hospital by Road Safety rescue team from upper Iweka outpost was confirmed dead by the doctor on duty and his body deposited at the morgue.

An eyewitness report showed the crash was caused by over-speeding and loss of control.

Following the injuries and the dead, the Sector Commander of Anambra Adeoye Irelewuyi has sympathised with the family of deceased and prayed for the injured for accelerated recovery.

He advised motorists to stop over-speeding which most time ended in road traffic crashes.
