## Woman Allegedly Conspires With Two Sons To Kill Grandson Over Land Dispute In Anambra

**A**nambra State Police Command has vowed to bring the murderers of little Uchechukwu Akana, one-year-old baby of Anaogu Umuoji in Idemili North Local Government Area of Anambra State to book.

Late little Uchechukwu Akana was said to have been murdered in the evening of October 6, 2021, by his father's brother over land matter at Anaogu Umuoji in Idemili North Local Government Area of Anambra State.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, Tochukwu Ikenga, while reacting to the death of the boy said men of the Ogidi Police Division have arrested the suspects and that the matter would be transferred to State CID for further investigation as one of the suspected accomplice, Tochukwu Akana, was on the run.

Narrating his ordeal, the deceased's father, Arinze Akana, detailed how the extended family agreed to sell the portion of the both family's land and share the money into two

two wives but his mother, Thressa Akana, mislead her two sons, Kosisochukwu and Tochuchukwu Akana, telling them that they are the bona fide owner of the land and that since he refused to remove his hand from the land that they would kill him.

Arinze said that series of peace meetings scheduled by elders in Anaogu yielded not fruits as his brothers refused

to attend.

He said, "I thought that it was a joke as they continued threatening me and my family."

He said that on that fateful day Kosisochukwu Akana brought a land buyer who insisted that the elderly person in the family must sign the documents but "as they prepared the documents without the son of the other woman

as we previously agreed I told them that I will not sign the documents till our mother comes back to enable me ask some questions about what our father said before his death.

"Unfortunately, my brothers, Tochukwu and Kosisochukwu Akana, clamped on me with matchet, digger and rod and hit the rod on my back. Then Touchukwu

matcheted me on my two legs and Kosisochukwu hit me with the rod and starting blood gushing out. They pushed inside my room as I was sitting beside my room.

"Immediately, Kosisochukwu Akana hit the rod on my son's head and the brain burst out and Tochuchukwu warned me that this is a lesson for me. Then my sister carried my son and rushed to hospital but he has died.

"The corpse of the little boy was lying at the compound when my mother came back from the market and entered our parlour jubilating that this serves as a lesson to me, the truthful man, laughing at me."

"Despite that my son was murdered in cold blood, they

have continued to threaten me. Tochukwu the next day brought one native doctor and they did incantation on the ground where my late son's blood spilled on the ground, circled it with charcoal and white chalk and calling my wife 'albino.'"

The mother of the dead child, Mrs. Chi Arinze Akana cried bitterly over how her brothers-in-law and mother planned and murdered her son.

She said, "They had been calling me albino with all sorts of maltreatments, humiliating me and my husband because I am from Amiri Oru West of Imo State and they killed my son threatening to kill me and my husband.

"I had been leaving in peace with my husband since he married me. Had I known that they meant all their threats would have taken my son and ran to my father's house," she lamented.
