

Six Feared Dead In Ebonyi Auto Crash

No fewer than six persons have been feared dead while three others hospitalised in an auto crash in Ebonyi State.

It was gathered that the incident occurred at Ndi-Uduma village, Oso Edda community, in the Afikpo South Local Government Area, of the state.

The accident, our Correspondent gathered, involved a MACK truck conveying chippings from Amasiri community in Afikpo North LGA of the state and a Sienna bus carrying passengers from Okigwe Local Government Area of Imo State on Wednesday.

A source from the area, Mr. Sunday Ugbor, told our Correspondent that the MACK truck collided with the Sienna bus along Ihere Stream, in the area.

"It is true and as I speak with you now, six persons died on the spot, and about three persons are just being moved to the hospital.

"It is a very fatal accident. It involved a Sienna bus carrying passengers from Okigwe in Imo State and a MACK truck conveying chippings from the Afikpo North LGA side.

"The two vehicles collided on a bend at the Ihere Stream and six of the passengers died instantly."
