One Robbery Suspect Killed, Three Arrested, One AK 47, 26 Ammunitions Recovered In Delta

Police operatives in Delta State on Tuesday shot dead one member of a robbery gang during their operation in Effurun/ Warri Axis of Delta State.

Daily Independent gathered through the Police Public Relation Officer, (PPRO), DSP Bright Edafe that the deceased who was in the company of his gang members were engaged in a gun duel by a combined team of Police men attached to Ekpan Police Station and Effurun community vigilante during a robbery operation along Aka Avenue of Jakpa road.

It was learnt that the deceased sustained bullet wound while other members of his gang escaped.

It was gathered that the injured suspect was taken to the hospital where he died while

receiving treatment.

Meanwhile, one locally made pistol, one expended cartridge, one live cartridge, 26 live 5.56mm ammunition and one empty AK 47 magazines were recovered.

In a related development, the police have nabbed three suspected armed robbers while on their way for a robbery operation.

The suspects; Chuks Abah 'm' age 23yrs of No. 42 Zion Street Bonsaac Asaba, Ogbonna Micheal 'm' age 37yrs of St. Calistol Oju Oduke Asaba and Amechi Mordi 'm' age 22yrs of Bonsaac Asaba were nabbed on the 31/10/2021 at about 1330hrs.

It was learnt that the suspects were intercepted by a Operation Delta Hawk in a blue colour Qlink 150 motorcycle with Reg. No. Delta LEH 259 QN and Eng. No. QL162F-NJ-1 at Bonsaac General Area Asaba.

It was revealed that the suspects were nabbed with one locally fabricated double barrel pistol recovered from a bag allegedly belonging to rider Chuks Abah during a search as a result of reasonable suspicion.

However, Commissioner of Police CP Ari Muhammed Ali has assured members of the public of the commitment of the Command in tackling crime and criminality in the state.

He also maintained that efforts are ongoing to apprehend fleeing suspects involved in the reported cases.
