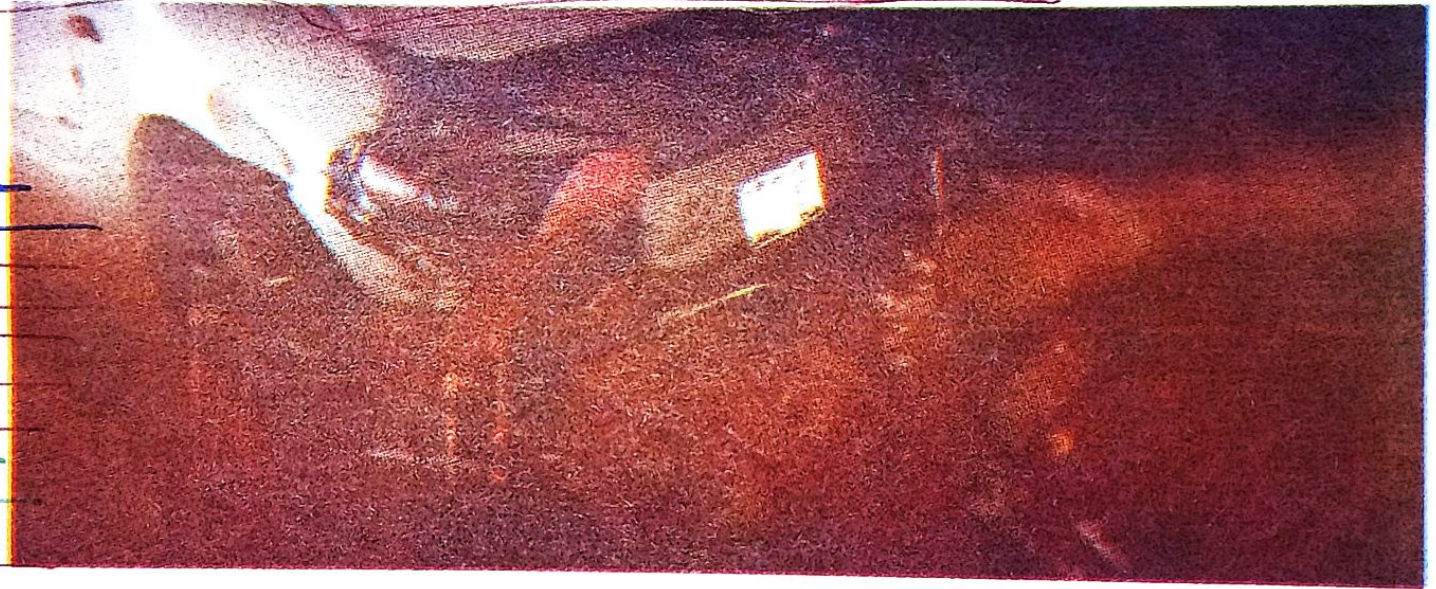


# \*Black Christmas In Bauchi Community As Four Die In Motor Accidents

Residents of Bogoro LGA in Bauchi State were thrown into mourning following the death of four people who were reportedly killed in multiple road accidents that occurred between Sunday and Monday night of December 2021.

1 According to reports made available to newsmen, on Sunday, 26th December, a commercial motorcyclist known as Nenfort and a resident of Jangyar village lost his life when he was conveying his sister to Gyara through a motorcycle accident.

The sister's wedding was billed to take place on Tuesday, 28th December, though she was seriously injured by breaking a leg, her brother Nenfort, unfortunately was not that lucky to survive the accident.

Though she is bedridden, the wedding as of the time of filing this report, took place on Tuesday despite her broken leg as sympathisers are praying God to continue to comfort the family and heal the beloved sister.

A friend of the deceased, James while speaking said that on Sunday, the 26th of December in the morning, he spoke with Nenfort to take him to Lafiya Sara

but he reluctantly declined pleading that he wanted to go to Church.

"I was at home when a friend told me about the accident and I could not stop sorrowing. May your soul rest in peace Nenfort as the wedding was going on, we received another sad news that two young men were found dead in Samiya village," he said.

2 He said that the victims,

Miss Ruth John, a resident of Ndukum and Mr. Wulum-bu hailed from Gambar Lere village who just came from Lagos were found dead early morning of Tuesday.

3 According to unconfirmed report, the two young people were said to have been hit by a vehicle after they just attended a wedding ceremony and were on their way home before they met with their untimely death.
