Soldiers Dislodge ESN Operatives, Kill Many In Anambra

e Nigerian army in operation conduct ed with other security agricies has dislodered a notorious stronghold of the armedwingof the proscribed Indigenous Propleof Biafra (IPOB), the Eastern Security Network (ESN) killingmany in Lilutoust in Ihiala Local Government Area of Anambra State

The operation was jointly conducted by troops of 82 Divi sion, Nigerian Navy 211 Quick Response Group of the Nigerian Air Force, Department of State Services and the Nigeria Police.

Liluisaborder town between Imo and Anamhra states which soldiers said had been hitherto known to be used as operational base of the dissidents.

A statement issued by the Director of Army Public Relations. Brigadier-General Onverna Nwadrukwu, said the operation was conducted in the early hours of Monday January 17, 2022

It said the operation led to the neutralisation of some gummen in the fire fight that ensued.

According to the statement, after dislodging the dissidents from their fortress, the dogged troops recovered 10 pump action shotguns, two locally fabricated gans, one revolver pistol, rounds of 7.52mm special live cartridges. machetes and IPOB flags.

Other items recovered the statement continued, were mobilethones laptops among other CANCELOUS MEXIDOUS

"It was a well-coordinated dawn attack on the fortress,

where plans were being perfect ed to violently enforce the illegit imate sit at home declaration by the irredentist groups", the state ment added.

Sit-At-Home Order Paralyses Activities In Owerri

Meanwhile, the sit at home order slammed on residents of the South-Eastly IPOB in respect of the resumed trial of its leader. Mazi Nnamdi Karat on Tuesday again crippled movements and commercial activities in Imo State.

Compliance with the directive was total in all parts of the state especially in Owerri, the state capital where vehicles traders and barrow pushers disappeared from the roads while markets. shops, business centres, banks, schools and hotels all locked un

Worst hit in the state were settlements within the Imo West Senatorial District (Orlu zone), highly dreaded as the headquar tersof the ESN, which comprises 12 council areas

Our correspondent, who went round the ancient city of Orlu. parts of Orsu, Ideato North and South as well as the Oru East LGA noted scores of shops filling stations, kiosks all placed under lock and key while the ubiquitous okadariders were nowhere to be

The Owerri/Orlu Road, Owerri/Onitsha Road, Port-Harcourt Road, Aha Road, Okigwe and Umuahia roads which usual ly bubble with heavy traffic were all deserted just as police team patrolled the roads occasionally with some stationed at strategic functions.

serted roads and motor parks as there were no vehicles to disturb

Amobile food vendor, who operates her business with a wheel barrowand who simply gave her name as Ngozi, lamented lack of patronage as there were no customers to purchase her food.

"They have started again, I thought that the sit-at-home was over. They should stop this thing because whenever it happens, I do not sell food."

As at the time of filing this report, streets/roads in Owerri, Okigwe, Oguta and Mhaise were bereft of activities

Nnamdi Kanu's Trial **Continues Today**

In the meantime, the trial of detained leader of Indigenous People of Biafra (IPOB), Mazi Nnamdi Kanu, continues today

at the Federal High Court sitting in Abuia.

Trialjurke_Justice Binta Nyako, fixed the matter today following Tuesday's adjournment.

The court had adjourned on Tuesday due to Kanu's objection tothefreshamended charge filed against him by the Federal Govemment.

Nnamdi Kanu's counsel, Mike Ozekhome (SAN), had accused the Federal Government of ambushing his client with the new change.

In addition, Ozekhome claimed that the proof of evidence attached to the amended change was not legible enough for their understanding of contents of the change

In view of the foresoing, the defence counsel pleaded for an adjournment to enable him have ample time to have full grasp of the charge.

Kanu had complained through his basiner that the Federal Government failed to promptly serve him with the fresh 15 count amended characfiled against him.

The IPOB leader further accused the Pederal Government of deriving him the necessary facility to defend the charge against him, adding that the amended charge was served on them barely 24 hours to Tuesday's sitting.
