

Gunmen Enforcing Sit-At-Home Kill APC Youth Leader, Another In Enugu

There was tension in Enugu as gunmen enforcing sit-at-home attacked Enugu South Local Government Area office of the All Progressives Congress (APC) during their meeting and shot dead the state youth leader of the party, Mr. Kelvin Ezeoha, and one other member.

This is coming as the sit-at-home order entered the third day in Enugu, paralysing activities in the state.

The order which commenced on Monday despite the cancelation by IPOB has kept residents of the state at home.

It was gathered that members of the party from Ward III, Obeagu Awkunanaw, Enugu South Local Govern-

ment Area, were having a reconciliation meeting at the party office located in their ward when the armed gunmen numbering over seven stormed the venue killing the two party members instantly while whisking away one other person.

A chieftain of the party, who spoke to *Daily Independent* on condition of anonymity, said, "Some gunmen invaded Enugu South LGA APC meeting this evening while their meeting was in progress, opened fire on the party members."

He said, "They killed the immediate past Enugu South Local Government Area chairman of the party, now the incumbent state youth leader, Mr. Kelvin Ezeoha, and one other person, while a party member was kidnapped.
