

# DSS Nabs Suspected Ogun Land Grabber Over Murder Case

An suspected land grabber, Elijah Adeogun, otherwise known as "killer," has been arrested by the operatives of the Department of State Security Service (DSS).

Daily Independent gathered that he was whisked away Monday morning when the operatives stormed Ikeshi area of Obasanjo, along Idoroko Road in Ogun State.

It was gathered that the now detained Adeogun who was being investigated by the DSS operatives had again been linked with another alleged murder of Idowu Arinadegbo, who was killed in 2013 in the same Ikeshi community.

The alleged land terrorist was arrested for allegedly killing two persons, Monday Eredua and Moruf Babalola in 2021 in the Ipetu Baba Ode Community in the Ado-Odo/ Ota Local Government area of Ogun State.

Members of the Isile Gbo Isele Gblobalabalaya family in a petition to the director of the Ogun State command of DSS accused the detained suspect of killing Arinadegbo.

The family also described it as surprising that the Director of Public Prosecution in Ogun State has not given any legal advice on the murder of Arinadegbo since 2013.

Isile Obalaya family commended the DSS for the feat to arrest the suspect who according to them had been invincible.

The family then called on the security agency to use the opportunity of this arrest to investigate the murder of Arinadegbo since 2013.

A letter by the family's lawyer, Barrister A. Popoola to the DSS stated, "Our client firstly commend the efforts of the DSS for her efforts in apprehending Elijah Adeogun a.k.a. 'Bullet, Killer '
