Terrorists' Attack In Katsina Leaves Twelve Persons Dead

Katsina – The police in Katsina have confirmed the early morning terrorists' attack that led to the killing of twelve people at Gakurdi village in Jibia Local Government Area of the state.

Similarly, the terrorists were said to have destroyed some farmlands belonging to the residents of the village during their early hour operation on Tuesday.

The terrorists, who arrived the village on four motorcycles, started shooting sporadically to scare the residents that began scampering for safety.

SP Gambo Isah, the state's command spokesperson, who confirmed the development added that some villagers who attempted to escape through their farmlands also got shot by the terrorists.

He said the Commissioner of Police, Idris Dabban, had led a team of security operatives to the village to get an on-the-spot assessment of the incident.

Isah, however, maintained that the security operatives were on top of the situation.

"The incident is true. The bandits were at the village this (Tuesday) morning and killed twelve villagers", he confirmed.

Meanwhile, a source, who spoke on anonymity with our reporter, said some unspecified number of domestic animals were rustled by the terrorists from a nearby village (Danye Gaba) before escaping into the forests.
