



Flood Claims Lives, Render Hundreds Homeless In Jigawa

Seven people have been confirmed dead while thousands of families were rendered homeless as a result of a downpour in Jigawa State.

Reports from the state indicated that the flood ravaged the state and was worse in seven local government areas.

The most affected local government areas include Dutse, the capital city of the state, Hadejia, Gwaram and Kafin Hausa local government areas.

Other local government areas are Kirikasamma, Guri, Auyo and Jahun local government areas.

In Kiri-Kasamma council the flood has claimed five lives, while two lives were lost in Bulangu, and five in Kafin Hausa local government areas in the state.

Contacted, the executive secretary of the state's Emergency Relief Management Agency,

Alhaji Sani Yusuf Babura, confirmed the incident, noting that "the disaster affected several local government areas."

Babura explained that three people died in Likori town, two died in Kira village of Kiri-

kasamma local government area while seven people were injured and admitted in Hadejia general hospital."

He said that two others died in Bulangu town at Kafin Hausa local government area while

houses, livestock, foodst items and farm produce worth millions of naira at Ayama, Jura and Kafin Hausa towns of Auyo and Kafin Hausa local government areas were destroyed by the downpour.
