

## Gunmen Kill Bread Distributor In Delta

A 35-year-old housewife, Mrs Emuobohwo (surname withheld) has been shot dead by unidentified gunmen in the suburb of Ovu town, Ethiope East local government, Delta State while on her way to the market to distribute bread.

The incident occurred when the victim left her home in Kokori at 5:00am in her Gulf II car loaded with bread at a bakery in Okpara Inland.

It was gathered that on arriving at a speed breaker on the road by the railway crossing, she was stopped by a gang of armed gunmen who shot her at close range on her forehead as she alighted from the car. Her lifeless body was found with arms on the ground and legs inside the car.

Mrs Eferaye Ojevwe, a bread distributor on her way to the market who happened on the scene raised the alarm, which attracted passers-by.

According to her, the Divisional Police Officer (DPO) Isiokolo Police division and his team immediately went to the scene when informed of the incident.

A purse containing N850 and a handset belonging to the deceased were found in the car. The Police later took the remains of the deceased to a mortuary in a nearby hospital at Okpara.

Speaking to our correspondent, ASP Lucky Uyabeme assured that the police were hunting the gunmen, adding that some persons have been arrested for questioning over the incident.
