Bus Driver Shot Dead By Armed Robbers

Men suspected to be armed robbers have shot and killed a commercial bus driver, Malam Sada Muhammad, at Dankyandi village in Malumfashi local government area of Katsina State.

It was gathered that the driver ran into the gang of armed robbers while returning from Kano around 10:00 pm.

An eyewitness, Musa Kakanda, who was in the vehicle when the incident occurred, told LEADERSHIP that the armed men shot the driver after asking him to stop.

Kakanda said the armed men shot the driver upon realising that he had hit one of them who was on the road, obviously to stop oncoming vehicles.

"They did not erect any barrier to block their victims but were only flashing torch lights and our driver who was on high speed hit one of them who was stationed at the centre of the road to stop on-coming vehicles," he narrated.

Kakanda said upon realising that one of their gang members was hit by the vehicle, the armed men deflated the vehicle's tyre and when the bus stopped, they pumped bullets into the driver, killing him at the spot.

He said the armed men fled the scene without touching any passenger or their belongings.
