Military Kills Scores Of Insurgents In Borno

Military authorities in Borno State said scores of Boko Haram terrorists performing burial funeral for their dead colleagues were killed during air raids yesterday in a village in Konduga local government area of the state.

Spokesman of the 7 Division in Maiduguri, Col Muhammed Dole, who confirmed this via an emailed statement to journalists, said another air raid on terrorists in Gwoza area, 130km south of Maiduguri, had killed eight of the terrorists.

Col Dole's statement reads: "Air bombardment of insurgents' hideouts in Mainok and Mada general areas of Kaga and Konduga LGAs by the Nigerian Air Force have claimed the lives of some Boko Haram terrorists. The terrorists were conducting funeral rites for their dead members around Mudube village.

"In a related operation, troops of 7 Division had an encounter with Boko Haram insurgents along Maiduguri-Bama-Gwoza road for two hours during which eight Boko Haram terrorists were killed, three Vehicles and three AK 47 rifles were burnt, while scores of others fled with various degrees of injuries.
