

Carpenter, 30, Electrocuted In Oyo

A 30-year-old carpenter identified as Lekan Ogundele was, on Thursday, electrocuted at the Amijoko compound, Isale Oyo, Oyo State.

The deceased was replacing some damaged roofing sheets with new ones in his house when he stepped on a 'live' wire and was electrocuted straight away.

The police public relations officer (PPRO) DSP Olabisi Ilobanafor who confirmed the incident in Ibadan on

Thursday, said the deceased was confirmed dead at the Opabode Hospital, Oyo.

Ilobanafor affirmed that the police team visited the scene of the incident and that the corpse had been deposited at the State Hospital for autopsy.

She also disclosed that investigation into the matter is still on-going.

According to her, the incident was reported at the police station by one Alhaji Tihamiyu Adejare, who resides at the Amijoko Compound, Isale Oyo.
