

Tenant Kills Pregnant Woman After Smoking Weeds

An aggrieved tenant, Moses Orokpokpo, in Edukuwu street, Warri, Delta State, has allegedly killed a pregnant neighbour, who is carrying a pregnancy of six months, after he allegedly took some illicit drugs.

The incident which occurred on January 2, 2014, generated pandemonium in the street where they lived as it was gathered that many of them have deserted their homes for fear of the unknown.

Reports said that the young man was believed to have suffered temporary madness after he allegedly smoked two raps of Indian hems. Neighbours recounted that he forced him way into his neigh-

bour's apartment and hacked her with an iron rod that left her in a pool of blood.

Although neighbours and sympathisers rushed her to a nearby hospital, she gave up the ghost midway to the hospital.

It was gathered that the culprit fled into a forest when the woman died, but he was trailed, apprehended and handed over to the police by vigilante group members.

While police officers at the Warri Police division confirmed the incident, they maintained that the culprit would be tested to ascertain his mental fitness, and prosecuted afterwards. The acting police spokesman in the state, DSP Charles Muka, however, said he was yet to receive the report.
