Gunmen Kill 4 Policemen In Kaduna

Unknown gunmen yesterday killed four police officers along Kagoro in Tudun -Wada area of Kaduna metropolis.

The Kaduna State Police Public Relations Officer (PPRO), DSP Aminu Lawan, who confirmed the incident to LEADERSHIP last night, stated that the police officer were attacked by the gunmen after office hours.

He further claimed that the gunmen ambushed the police officers who were being conveyed home by a private commercial vehicle after closing of work inside the community.

Lawan said, "The gunmen shot the officers including their driver who was a civilian and they were taken to the hospital where they later died of the bullet wounds."

According to an eyewitness, the police officers had just closed from their duty post at a bank and were to be conveyed to their offices when they were attacked by the gunmen

He said: "The gunmen just came from nowhere on a motor-cycle and opened fire on the police officers who just closed from duty at the bank.

Everybody started scampering for safety before security agents took control and cordoned off the area.

"The gunmen zoomed off as they continued to shoot sporadically, leaving the lifeless bodies of the victims in the pool of their own blood".
