Police Foil Attempt To Kidnap Kwankwaso's Father

The Kano State Police Command yesterday foiled an attempt by kidnappers to abduct Alhaji Musa Kwankwaso, father of Kano State governor Rabiu MusaKwankwaso.

The incident happened at about 7:30pm in Kwankwaso town, the governor's hometown in Madobi local government area of the state.

Though details of the attempted abduction were sketchy at press time, LEAD-ERSHIP gathered that three policemen died during the shootout between policemen guarding the governor's father and the gunmen.

It was further gathered that the governor's father is unhurt and now in protective custody.

An eyewitness further told LEADERSHIP last night that the governor's father and some other Muslim faithful were coming from the mosque after their Isha'i prayers when the attackers struck.

A military vehicle was seen conveying bodies of wounded individuals lying down in the

ing through Sharada Road to Kwankwaso town. Sources confirmed seeing the military vehicle going into Kano Government House.
