

Man Tortured To Death For Stealing N74,000

The Enugu State Police Command has commenced investigations into the murder of one Chukwuemeka Ugwa who was tortured to death for allegedly stealing N74,000.

A statement by the command's Public Relations Officer, Ebere Amaraizu, made available to LEADERSHIP said the deceased, a twin brother to one Chukwudi Ugwa was chained and tortured to death at a town hall in Oji River local Government area of Enugu state for allegedly stealing the said money.

The statement said six persons had been arrested by the operatives of the state command in connection with the murder.

"The six persons arrested who gave their names as Eric Nnebedum, Christopher Onyeahzi, Christopher Ejeagbasi, Kingsley Ajala, Ifeanyi Ekwusi and Clement Orji are helping the police in their investigations over their alleged involvement in the murder of Chukwuemeka Ugwa a twin brother to one Chukwudi Ugwa whom suspects allegedly conspired and chained at the town hall located at Ubaha in Oji river local government area of Enugu state on 8/2/14 where they allegedly tortured the victim to death for allegedly stealing the sum of N74,000.

"The deceased's corpse is now deposited at the General Hospital mortuary, Oji River for necessary action," the statement read.
