Court Remands Man For Injecting Woman To Death

An Ado-Ekiti Chief Magistrates' Court yesterday remanded a 65-year-old man, Oluwande Ajayi in prison custody for allegedly injecting a woman to death.

The prosecutor, Emmanuel David told the court that the accused committed the offence on January 23, at Ise-Ekiti.

David said the accused unlawfully injected Toyin Arogunmatide to death with a dose yet to be determined, adding that the offence contravenes Section 319(1) of the Criminal Code of Ekiti State, 2012.

The plea of the accused was not taken and the Chief Magistrate, Abayomi Adeosun remanded the accused in prison custody and adjourned the case to April 18, for further mention.
