## 3 Killed In Crisis Over Iye-Ubu River

At least three persons were reportedly feared killed in the prevailing crisis between two warring groups at Ogbe-Ubu quarters in Ogwashi-Uku, near Asaba, over the control of the major source of the community's revenue, the Iye-Ubu River.

LEADERSHIP gathered that the crisis which started at the weekend has heightened tension in the community and also led to water shortage within Ogwashi Uku town and environs as water tanker operators had withdrawn their services from the community, pending the resolution to the crisis.

Although the crisis has been reportedly resolved, residents of Ogwashi-uku who are solely dependent on the water tanker operators to supply water to the town from the popular Iyi-Ubu River still appeared to be at each other's jugulars as to who collects the revenue accruing from the river.
