Gunmen Kill NBTE Director In Kaduna

A deputy director with the National Board for Technical Education (NBTE), Mohammed Adamu was shot dead yesterday by unknown gunmen in Kaduna.

LEADERSHIP gathered last night that the NBTE director was shot by the assailants in front of his residence in Kinkinau, GRA, Kaduna.

A source close to the deceased told LEADERSHIP that "the deceased just returned from Abuja on official assignment, and the gunmen approached him and asked whether he was Mohammed Adamu; he said yes and they fired gunshots at him four times and ran away."

"He was immediately rushed to the hospital and was confirmed dead," the source added.

Another source told LEADERSHIP that the victim was shot dead in front of a shop near his house while attempting to alight from his car to purchase some items at about 9pm yesterday.

"The shop owner who witnessed the shooting fainted because of the horror but was revived around midnight," the source said.

A police source who spoke to our reporter said the victim's vehicle was abandoned by the assailants.
