Man, 65, Murdered By Cousin Over Plot Of Land

Tension has heightened in Obiagu Ada Imilike Agu Community in Udenu local government area of Enugu State, following the murder of a 65-year-old man by his cousin over a parcel of land.

A release made available to LEADERSHIP FRIDAY by the Enugu State Police Public Relations Officer, Ebere Amaraizu, stated that the deceased, identified as Christopher Eze, was murdered by his cousin, Chiebolam Eze, last Wednesday following a disagreement over a parcel of land.

Amaraizu disclosed that the command had commenced investigations into the matter and uncovered that the deceased was accused of conspiring with some people to destroy art works belonging to the suspect.

"The Enugu command of the Nigeria Police Force, through its operatives, have commenced investigations into an alleged incident of murder that allegedly occurred on 5/3/14 at Obiagu Ada Imilike Agu in Udenu local government area of Enugu State where it was alleged that one Christopher Eze, believed to be about 65 years old, was murdered by his cousin identified as Chiebolam Eze.

"It was gathered that the suspect was allegedly having an issue with the deceased over a plot of land and, also, that the deceased conspired with others and allegedly destroyed the arts works of the suspect and when the suspect tried to find out things from the deceased, he allegedly raised a cutlass to cut the suspect which he dodged and, in the ensuing struggle, he hit his uncle [now deceased] with a stick on the head.

As a result, this allegedly led to the death-on-the-spot of Eze.
