

Cattle Herd Kill Man In Delta

A cattle herd has allegedly killed a middleaged man identified as Chuks Oboh in Isah, Ogwashi-Uku, Delta State while on his way to Ubulu-Uku community on a motorcycle.

Recall that in December 2013, a guard with the state-owned polytechnic was reportedly crushed to death by a herd of cattle on the Edo-Ogwashi-Uku while on his way to work from Ubulu-Okiti, his home town.

LEADERSHIP reliably gathered that the victim of the latest incident ran into the cattle while they were crossing the road and could not control his speed, thereby ramming into them.

Witnesses said the victim died at the spot

while the herdsmen allegedly ran away with their cattle.

Meanwhile, Oghara the administrative headquarters of Ethiope West local governemnt area of the state has been thrown into mourning following the alleged shooting and killing of a man in Ovade community, near Oghara.

LEADERSHIP gathered that following incessant assaults and killing of Oghara indigenes by suspected Fulani herdsmen, the vigilante group in Oghara with the consent of the elders recently went into the bush with the intention of cautioning the suspected herdsmen to stop further assaults on the people but the herdsmen allegedly attacked and killed one of them.
