MURDER: Man Beats Wife To Death For Denying Him Sex

The police in Plateau State has arrested one Benjamin Toma, who allegedly beat his wife to death because she denied him sex.

The state police commissioner, Chris Olakpe who disclosed this yesterday, said the suspect beat his wife to death and later hung her body to cover up the crime.

"On March 4, 2014, at about 7:30 hours, Chuwang Sambo of Larwa village in Heipang District of Barkin Ladi local government reported that one Benjamin Toma of Foron Junction, also in Barkin Ladi, beat his wife, Victoria, aged 25, to death and later hung her body.

"The reason for his action was as a result of his wife's refusal to submit herself to him for sexual intercourse," he narrated.

Olakpe, according to African Examiner, said the suspect would soon be charged to court.

Meanwhile, sources close to the suspect said his wife refused to have sex with him because he tested positive to the HIV virus.
