Death Of Pregnant Woman Unsettles Delta, Fake Medical Personnel On The Prowl

The death of a pregnant woman identified as Mrs Ifekachukwu Ideh at a private medical centre along Okpanam Road, Asaba, Delta State has unsettled the state government who had last Friday vowed to investigate the circumstances surrounding her death.

LEADERSHIP Sunday reliably gathered that the pregnant woman allegedly bled to death at the Ark Medical Centre where the medical personnel was allegedly nonchalant to save her life.

But the state commissioner for Health, Dr Joseph Otumara, while reacting to the death of the pregnant woman, told LEADERSHIP Sunday that the state government was poised on a full scale investigation into the death.

While saying that the death of the woman has upset the state government who has been committed to healthcare services in the state especially free mortality healthcare, the commissioner disclosed that a committee has been set up to investigate the circumstances surrounding the death of the woman at the hospital.
