

DEATH: Burglar Falls From Ceiling With N2.2M, Dies

An unidentified suspected burglar met his Waterloo in Apapa area of Lagos State on Sunday, when he fell from the ceiling of a company building.

The burglar was said to have broken into an electronic superstore, Beko Home Appliances, along Warehouse Road and stole N2.2million cash.

When the warehouse was opened on Monday, the burglar whose hair was weaved was lying in the pool of his blood and was certified dead while the cash he stashed in a bag was intact.

The corpse was later removed by policemen attached to the Area 'B' Apapa Com-

mand.

When LEADERSHIP visited the command for confirmation of the report yesterday, the Commander, ACP Ndubueze Anene, "Please go. I can't talk to you about it. I and my policemen were patrolling the area that night and I've been praying to my God not to allow any operation of criminals succeed in this area. God has answered my prayer. The burglar died in the process at the scene of crime."

A source at the station however told LEADERSHIP that during their patrol on the night of the incident, the police were blaring siren and the thief may have heard the sound and thought they were coming after him and may have in fear, fallen from the ceiling.
