

Suspected Fulani Militia Kill 7 In Benue

Gunmen suspected to be Fulani militia yesterday invaded three communities in Logo local government area of Benue state and killed 7 people.

LEADERSHIP WEEKEND gathered that over 100 suspected Fulani herdsmen stormed Chembe, Ife and Tse-Gundu villages of Gaambe-Tiev at about 2am and ransacked the communities. The attack lasted for several hours and scores of persons have been declared missing.

The affected villages are located few kilometers from Anyiin, hometown of Governor Gabriel Suswam. The militia also destroyed houses around Anawah settlement in Ukemberagya in Tswarev ward of Logo LGA of state.

The heinous attack is coming barely two weeks after the national leadership of Miyetta Allah and Benue State peace building and reconciliation committee signed a peace deal and agreed to cease fire.
