## VIO Officer Killed In Line Of WEFA Special Duty Laid To Rest

It was all tears, wailings and gnashing of teeth yesterday in Oye-Ekiti, Ekiti State when the remains of the felled Vehicle Inspection Officer from the Directorate of Road Transport, Engr. Ogunyemi Philip Olusegun, was finally laid to rest Friday.

The journey to the great beyond of Engr. Olusegun began during the World Economic Forum on Africa (WEFA) which held in Abuja last week.
