COMMUNAL CLASH: 3 Die In Delta Communities

A protracted youth restiveness has claimed the lives of three persons in Ughelli Communities, leaving the community in confusion.

It was gathered that there have been several cult clashes between members of rival cult groups and a popular cult group, called Eiye confraternity.

They were said to have displayed guns and other dangerous weapons during the clashes.

Apart from the problem of youth restiveness, indications are that the community has been faced with multi-faceted problems, ranging from child prostitution, cultism, drunkenness, and idleness.

It was gathered that at weekends, drinking parlors and other joints are filled to the brim, including fast food joints and hotels, especially around Patani road popularly called Dumez road, where there are semi half naked drunk teenage girls committing all manner of atrocities.

But the Police Public Relations Officer in the State, DSP Celestina Kalu, said that some persons have been arrested in connection with the nefarious activities in the community, adding that on completion of investigations, they would be charged to court.
