MURDER: Man In Police Net Over Neighbour's Death

A middle aged man identified as Joseph Obakpor, is currently helping the police in Ogwashi-Uku near Asaba, Delta State, over his courage to unravel the mystery surrounding the death of one of his neighbours; Awulu Okoh in Ogbe-Ofu quarters, Ubulu-Unor.

It was reliably gathered that the remains of the said victim was recovered somewhere along Ogwashi-uku/Kwale road high way road already mutilated from unknown incident, which the suspect was said to have disclosed to the police.

The woman on reaching the hospital was told that there was no accident victim in the hospital and while she was coming back she saw the body of the husband lying on the road mutilated from bashing by motorists who often drive past.
