DEATH: Farmer Dies In River

Tragedy struck last weekend when the body of Mr Ojo Olaoye, a farmer at Omi-funfun, a suburb of Odode Idanre in Idanre Local Government Area of Ondo State, was found at a river in the area after being declared missing for two weeks.

The late Olaoye was said to have been to his farm two weeks ago to harvest some of his farm produce which he intended to sell so as to raise some money to host his monthly club meeting in Akure.

He was said to have taken the farm produce to the market for sale but never returned home since then.

His family members and wives were said to have since then been searching for him. All efforts to find him were fruit-

less as they could not find him alive, until his corpse was discovered in a River last weekend.

While speaking with LEADERS, some of his neighbours and family members in Akure said that he went on Friday, August 15 and was expected to come back on Saturday as usual but he didn't show up. They added that they tried all their best to reach him but could not be reached.

"When we called his phone and it was not reachable, we decided to go to the house of his new wife, maybe he was there, but on getting there, they told us that she did not know his whereabouts. We went to meet his elder brother in the village and he told us he did not see him when he was going to the market."
