

ACCIDENT: 12 Die In Auto Crash

No fewer than 12 persons were said to have perished in a ghastly motor accident around Oghara Bridge, Ethiope West Local Government Area of Delta State.

Reports said that the victims were on their way back from Koko community headquarters of Warri North Local Government Area to Sapele, after they were hired to go and register for a multipurpose cooperative society.

According to sources, the bus conveying

the passengers entered into a pot-hole and somersaulted while descending the Oghara bridge.

It was gathered that the survivors, who are currently receiving treatment in a private hospital in Sapele blamed the accident on over speeding on the part of the driver.

Some officials of the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC) who do not want their names in print, confirmed that corpses of the victims have been deposited in private hospital mortuaries while those who survived are receiving treatment.
