

DEATH: Lifeless Body Found In Stream

Residents of Agbo-Oba and Kuntu communities in Ilorin West local government area of Kwara State were thrown into panic following the discovery of lifeless body of a middle-aged man in a stream.

It was gathered that the corpse of the unidentified man was found in a stream behind Victory Hotel in the early hours of Sunday.

A resident in the area, who pleaded anonymity, said that they suspected that the corpse of the man might have been dumped in the stream at night by cultists.

The source added that though some residents sighted the suspected cultists, no one could however challenge them because they were armed with dangerous weapons.

Another source, also a resident of the area said

that "we heard strange voices around our house in the night but we thought it was those of night guards."

"But when we woke up early in the morning, we saw a large gathering of people at the scene of the incident and when I moved closer to know what actually happened, I saw the lifeless body of a young man in the stream".

It was gathered that a resident in the area later alerted policemen at Surulere 'C' division on the incident. The lifeless body of the victim had been evacuated by the police.

When contacted, the spokesman of the state police command, Ajayi Okasanmi (ASP) confirmed the incident and added that the remains of the deceased had been deposited at University of Ilorin Teaching Hospital (UIH) morgue while police investigation has commenced on the incident.
