DEATH: Cable Vandal Electrocuted

A yet-to-be identified middle-aged man suspected to be a cable vandal has been found dead near a transformer sub-station in Ka municipal.

It was gathered that the lifeless body of the suspected cable vandal was found, Wednesday, near a transformer at the popular Op Air Theatre along Jibiya road in Katsina metropolis.

Sources said staffers of the Katsina State History and Culture Bureau who resumed for work at the Katsina Open Air Theatre, reportedly found the lifeless body of the deceased and they called the men of the National Security and Civil Defence Corps (NSC believed to be on patrol around the area".

While addressing reporters at the scene of the incident, the head of anti vandal unit of the Command, CSC Bishir Dansada Kurfi, stated that his men who were on patrol, were alerted by the officials of the Katsina State History and Culture Bureau and quickly rushed to the scene.

Kurfi said preliminary findings revealed that the deceased was out on a mission to vandalise cables and may have met his untime death while attempting to disconnect cables from the transformer.
