## Ibadan Fire: Residents, Traders Mourn

Residents, including traders of the popular Molete Market, Ibadan, Oyo State, yesterday continued mourning and lamenting the death of several people who lost their lives in an inferno which occurred as a result of a burnt petrol tanker in the area on Saturday night.

When LEADERSHIP visited the scene on Sunday, an eyewitness put the figures of the dead at 70, while another eyewitness who is an Okada operator said corpses of those who died were initially deposited inside two commercial buses after the incident on Saturday night before they were taken out for burial.

The atmosphere in and around Molete was sober throughout as sympathisers as well as those whose shops and vehicles were burnt were seen milling around.

Also, no fewer than 70 vehicles were severely burnt beyond repairs.

Inside one of the burnt vehicles, a private car, were the remains of a burnt pregnant woman and two other bodies which witnesses said, were that of her children.

**Ajimobi, APC Sympathise With Traders**

Meanwhile, Oyo State governor, Senator Abiola has commiserated with the families of those who were burnt to death by the fire, praying that God will grant the repose of their souls.

The Oyo State Chapter of the All Progressives Congress (APC) in Oyo State has described the Saturday evening tanker inferno at Molete area, Ibadan, which led to the death of an unspecified number of innocent persons, as unfortunate despite the untiring efforts of the present administration to forestall the recurrence of such incident in all parts of the state.
