AUTO CRASH: Runaway Housewife Dies In Accident

A housewife's plan to loot the husband's treasury after allegedly collecting his cheque books in Asaba, Delta State, on Monday backfired when she died in an auto crash on her way to Benin City, Edo State.

Reports said the woman identified as Monica (surname withheld) had allegedly stolen the husband's cheque books to perfect her 'evil act' in Benin City with her accomplice when an auto crash claimed her life.

Speaking to our correspondent, the husband, a high chief in Asaba, who did not want his name in print, said, "I was shocked when a call came to me that my wife was involved in an auto crash along Benin-Asaba around Igbodo community. My cheque books were all recovered in her bag and I have been looking for the cheque books before she said she was traveling to Benin to see her relations."

The deceased, 42, who hailed from Benin and a mother of three children, is said to be the second wife of the Asaba high Chief.
