Jigawa Releases N6.62bn For Road Project

Jigawa State Executive Council has approved the release of N6.62billion for the dualisation of 11.4km road in Dutse, the state capital.

The state commissioner for information, youth, sports and culture, Alhaji Babandi Ibrahim revealed this while briefing newsmen on the outcome of the council's meeting yesterday.

He said the contract had been awarded to Dantata and Sawoe Construction Company and is expected to be completed in eight months.

Police Kill Robber, Arrest 3 Others In Kaduna

Kaduna State Police Command yesterday said that its men on patrol have killed one armed robber in a gun dwell at Malali in Kaduna North local government area of the state, while three others were arrested.

The police public relations officer (PPRO), SP Aminu Lawan disclosed this while speaking with newsmen in Kaduna yes-

terday.

According to him, four armed robbers on 20th October, 2014 attacked one Idris Shuaibu who runs a filling station opposite Federal Government College, Malali on his way home at the new Malali Layout, Kaduna.

He said, "Police patrol team on routine patrol heard the sound of gunshots and immediately dashed to the area.

"In a fierce gun battle that ensued between the robbers and the police, one of the robbers was killed while others escaped into a nearby bush with bullet wounds and abandoned a Honda Halla car which is their operational vehicle.

"When search was conducted on the vehicle, the following arms and ammunition were recovered: one AK 47 rifle, 177 rounds of 66mm live ammunition, Honda Halla with registration number AP 244 GWA and extra magazine of AK 47 rifle."
