Suspected killer local gin, otherwise known as "ogogoro," has reportedly killed two persons in Okolore, Kwale axis, Delta State.

Acting police spokesman in the state, ASP Uwuigbe Nosakhare, said the police were investigating the circumstances surroundings of their deaths.

He also revealed that the police detectives in Kwale had uncovered hideout for homosexuals and arrested the operator of the joint located near the T-Junction in the community.
